

Clonakilty Waterfront Marathon - Privacy Policy

General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR) will come into effect on 25th May 2018.

This privacy policy is a public statement of how the Clonakilty Waterfront Marathon applies data protection principles to processing personal data. The Clonakilty Waterfront Marathon takes matters relating to the privacy of the personal information that you provide extremely importantly. We fully understand and appreciate the level of trust you hold in us respecting your right to privacy.

Who is collecting your personal data

The personal data that you provide will be processed by the organisers of the Clonakilty Waterfront Marathon and the third parties list below in the document.

How does Clonakilty Waterfront Marathon collect personal data

Clonakilty Waterfront Marathon collects personal data through the following means:

- By online entry to the Clonakilty Waterfront Marathon through our third party partners
- By entry to the Clonakilty Waterfront Marathon at the event expo in the 24 hours preceding the event
- By recording the names and contact details of stewards/individuals/teams who support the event

What personal data does the Clonakilty Waterfront Marathon collect

All information collected by the Clonakilty Waterfront Marathon is done so in an open and transparent manner. We will request information that is necessary for us to process your request. We will not request information that is not required. Personal data will be provided willingly by each individual and is specifically related to the purpose for which they have made contact. The Clonakilty Waterfront Marathon only requests and holds the personal data of each individual that is required by the relationship/transaction at that time.

Personal information required can include:

- Name
- Address
- Date of Birth
- Email address
- Phone number
- Next of Kin
- Medical conditions/illnesses
- Running Club
- Country

The personal data that we collect from any individual will be used for the following purpose

- For registration purposes to the Clonakilty Waterfront Marathon.
- For purposes of posting race packs as requested.
- To contact all registered entrants in the lead up to the events with race updates.
- To award prizes for different age categories across all event distances
- To ensure that the Red Cross/other medical support are aware of all medical conditions relating to individual participants which will empower them to treat accordingly if there is a requirement to do so during the immediately before/during or immediately after the event.
- To contact any event participants next of kin if there is any required need to do so.
- To inform our race support crew stewards/physios etc. of their roles and responsibilities for the duration of the event.

Your Rights

If you wish to know what personal information we hold belonging to you, please inform us by email (info@runclon.ie) and we will respond to you outlining the process required for us to satisfy your request. We are also legally obliged to provide you with details of all personal information belonging to you, that we are in possession of upon your request.

Will data be shared with any 3rd party

The Clonakilty Waterfront Marathon engages the below Data Processors to store and process personal data on its behalf.

Under no circumstances will your information be sold or provided to a 3rd Party for the intention of contacting you outside of your specific requests which you have submitted to Clonakilty Waterfront Marathon.

How long will your personal information be stored for

We will hold your personal information on file for as long as the relationship between Clonakilty Waterfront Marathon and you remains in place. Once the purpose and/or time frame for holding your personal information has lapsed, we will permanently delete your personal information from our systems.

How can I be sure that my data is secure

The Clonakilty Waterfront Marathon complies with the Data Protection (amendment) Act 2003 and will collect, process, store and use your information in accordance to the act. Clonakilty Waterfront Marathon will take the necessary steps required to secure and protect your personal

data from loss, theft, misuse or alteration. We will however, inform you and the Data Protection Commission as required by law of any breach or concern related to your personal data.
